PLAYGROUND NAMING RIGHTS AND MAIN ROTARY PLAY STRUCTURE: \$2,500,000

A large sign will span the playground entrance proudly recognizing our generous \$2.5M donor, in honor or memory of a family or an individual along with the main playground highly visible when entering the area.

This Main Rotary Play Structure will be for children, ages 5-12. The design was inspired specifically by the Rotary Wheel, allowing circular movement and play flow through the varying playground components. Starting from ground level and reaching to a 12' height, this structure exceeds a typical playground design and is incredibly unique, since it is fully wheelchair accessible with connected play opportunities throughout the structure. As the structure spirals, the slides and climbers on the perimeter grow in size and challenge, allowing kids ages 5-12 the chance to grow with the structure throughout their childhood. No slide or climber on the structure is the same, providing opportunities for growth and repeated excitement.

ALTERNATE OPTIONS

PLAYGROUND NAMING RIGHTS: \$1,000,000

An option exists for the Playground Naming Rights to be separated from the Main Rotary Structure. Signage will appear independently from the equipment and visible when entering the area.

MAIN ROTARY PLAY STRUCTURE: \$500,000

ZIP KROOZ: \$200,000

The Zip Krooz provides every child with a chance to fly! The design allows children to experience fast linear movement from one end of the structure to the other. The pod seat provides a challenging seating option for those who want to really work their core muscles as they fly through space.

The Assist version includes a molded bucket seat with harness that gives every child a secure seating option to experience the ride. When combined with the Zip Krooz assist, these tracks combine to create a social element to the flying experience. Children can choose to race each other or develop imaginary games and scenarios as they ride side by side.



BAY OF SWINGS: \$160,000



FRIENDSHIP SWING

The Friendship Swing allows several children and adults of assorted sizes to swing together. The design allows those swinging to keep direct eye contact as they swing. This swing is also set at a transfer height for easy transfer from a wheelchair so that all can swing together.



OODLE SWING

The Oodle Swing provides oodles of fun for kids! This swing accommodates kids of all abilities who will love the back and forth motion.



TODDLER SEAT SWING

This is designed for little swingers on the playground. It provides them with additional support so they can enjoy their first swinging experiences.



The Belt Seat Swing is designed for children who have good core trunk control and can initiate their own swinging experiences.



MOLDED BUCKET SEATS

The Molded Bucket Seat with Harness and Chains provides greater stability for kids with limited upper-body strength.



AGES 2-5 PLAY AREA: \$150,000

This play area is designated specifically for little ones (ages 2-5) and begins with a hill play area that includes integrated slides, climbers, and steppers directly into the natural slope of the site.

Young playground goers will enjoy their own space to explore with equipment that is sized just right for them.

The integrated hill play allows users to run up and slide down the slide as many times as they'd like, without having to navigate steps and tighter spaces like on a traditional structure. This adds a unique element of freedom for little ones and is helpful for caregiver supervision.





WE-GO-SWING: \$120,000

This swing allows everyone to swing together.

The placement of the handlebars allows those seated in the seat or their wheelchair to contribute to the swinging motion ensuring that all are part of the swinging experience.

All children will actively engage the muscles throughout their body to make this swing soar. This helps them build their motor planning skills, strength, and balance as they swing.

There is plenty of room for children of all ages to sit and/ or stand together and enjoy a ride to the stars or take a gentle ride down the river or to any other world they can imagine.

FREESTANDING PLAY SPORTS AND FITNESS AREA: \$100,000

This specially designed area is for exercisers age 13 and above, seamlessly merging the benefits of a traditional gym with the serenity of the great outdoors.

This outdoor gym equipment offers a unique fitness experience for teens to elderly visitors. Whether you prefer a comprehensive workout circuit with integrated shade or individual stations, this equipment caters to a diverse range of preferences.







FIRE STATION AND MARKET: \$100,000

Pairing a Fire Station and a Market Café through a connecting elevated crawl tunnel gives kids two iconic structures to exercise their imaginations.

Whether they are keeping shops, making food, taking care of the fire station pet dog, or zooming to an emergency, young ones will delight in the many physical, imaginative, and learning activities they find while playing.

There are 21 interactive activities addressing developmentally appropriate skills. In addition, there are fire fighter uniforms with mirrors to look in, a radio handset, cash register, menu board and prompts to describe food tastes.

GLOBAL MOTION: \$75,000

The Global Motion is a rotating climber that children can enjoy with their friends. Social play abounds as children communicate with each other from the inside and the outside.

Global Motion also helps children work their muscles as they climb. Those pushing their friends get to work on motor planning and coordination.



SENSORY PLAY THRILLS: \$75,000



CURVA SPINNER

Provides children with a fun way to spin and rotate alone or together. It allows them to use their arms and leg muscles to play with the forces of gravity.

CHILL SPINNER

Provides children with a cozy seat where they can feel the pull of gravity as they spin.

The belted seat is set at an easy transfer height which allows children to be transferred from their wheelchair. The seat design provides support for every child allowing them to experience the fun of spinning.



BOOGIE BOARD

The Boogie Board provides children with a unique play experience that will challenge every child's sense of balance. Children can sit, stand, or lay on the Boogie Board during play helping them build an understanding of their position in space.

REVI WHEEL

This is a great place for a group of children of all abilities to explore vestibular movement together. It is designed so that children using wheeled mobility devices can easily transfer or be transferred out of their devices into the spinner.

All children can use the grab wheel in the center to rotate, building core and upper body strength as they play.

WE-GO-ROUND: \$70,000

The We-Go-Round is an inclusive merry-go-round designed so that all children can participate. A central post wheel lets kids spin it from both the inside and outside, encouraging everyone to contribute to the movement.

Its thoughtful design promotes cooperative social play, where riders and pushers work together to create a fun, spinning experience. Children using mobility devices can easily roll on and join the fun, enjoying the same dynamic, vestibular stimulation as their peers.



OUTDOOR MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS: \$60,000



This instrument has a full range of notes that children can play to create any song in their imagination.

The arched design of the chimes allows for easy roll-up access for those using wheelchairs to enjoy the rotation that comes from a merry-go-round experience.

These drums provide children with a fun drum experience. Children can explore these drums alone or with friends.

They help with eye-hand coordination as well as fine motor skills development.

SHELTERS: \$50,000



2 SPONSORS AVAILABLE

This large canopy shelter, a 4-post hard surface shelter, will provide cool and reliable shade for two picnic/seating areas.

It will block UV rays and keep temperatures cool on the hottest of days.

ROLLER TABLE: \$50.000

The rollers provide a child with a unique tactile and auditory experience while the upper bars encourage children to build upper body strength and motor coordination to roll across the table.

It is set at a height that allows easy transfer out of a wheelchair onto the table.







The Sway Fun provides a social gathering point where children can rest and still play. The placement of the table is a key component of its design.

This creates an opportunity for children using wheelchairs to actively participate in creating the movement of the Sway Fun. There is plenty of room for children of all ages to play together and enjoy the ride.

16' X 16' SHADE STRUCTURE - CANTILEVER: \$35,000



The Cantilever Single Post Pyramid Structure provides sun protection and heat reduction with a convenient offset single post.

It is a beautiful and economical way to provide shade at playgrounds.

WE-SAW: \$30,000



Provides children with movement up and down in space. Children can find the "just right" movement experience by sitting in the molded seats or on the center platform.

The design allows for two children or a group of children to join in the experience.

The seats are large enough to accommodate teens and adults, allowing the experience to become a true group hangout.

VIBRA CHIME: \$25,000



The Vibra Chimes include a full range of notes that children can use to play any song of their creation.

The arched design that supports each chime allows for easy roll-up access for those using wheelchairs.

The vibration produced by each chime provides a fun sensory experience for all.

COZY DOME: \$20,000



3 SPONSORS AVAILABLE

The Cozy Dome is a unique climber that is the perfect mix of a fun climber and a cozy place for children to escape to observe others playing.

The interior provides a great "time inn" space where those who get overwhelmed on the playground can go and check in for a sensory break.

REVI-WHIRL SPIN: \$20,000



The Revi-Whirl Spinner is a great place for a group of children of all abilities to explore movement together.

All children can use the grab wheel in the center to rotate, building core and upper body strength as they play.

This spinner encourages social play especially cooperation among children.

16' X 16' SHADE STRUCTURE - PYRAMID: \$15,000



The Single Post Pyramid Shade provides sun protection and heat reduction with a convenient offset single post that covers play equipment.

The post and fabric colors complement the environment.

SYMBOL COMMUNICATION SIGN: \$10,000



This sign is used to provide children who use Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC) systems with a way to communicate to their friends how they would like to play on the playground.

PICNIC TABLE: \$10,000

11 SPONSORS AVAILABLE

These sturdy tables provide a place to gather and share time or a meal with family and friends. They are made from recycled plastic slats. They will be four feet with two benches.





BENCHES: \$5,000

These sturdy benches provide all with a place to sit with added back support, whether they are taking a break from a morning or afternoon of activity or are just enjoying watching others play. They are made with recycled plastic slats.

TRASH CONTAINER: \$5,000

11 SPONSORS AVAILABLE

The trash containers are 32-gallon receptacles made of recycled plastic slats and will be located throughout the park.





BIKE RACK: \$3,000

This bike rack will hold both small and large bikes for kids who may want to bike to the playground.

FENCE SPONSORSHIP RECOGNITION

Naming Plaques on fencing that are around the perimeter of the playground will be available for purchase at the \$500 and \$1,000 level.
